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Passover - Creating a Festive Gathering

Some may wish to view the video of the Passover celebration as a group. We offer the following suggestions for items to have on hand for joining in with the video.

Ritual Items:

- •Elijah's cup can be a specially designated wine cup or wine glass
- Seder plate

A special plate (or any designated plate will work) upon which to put these items

- •1 Hard Boiled Egg Parsley
- •Salt water in a small bowl for dipping
- •Bitter Herbs = Horseradish cut into small pieces, horseradish sauce or bitter lettuce
- •Shank bone or other small symbolic bone for the Seder plate. Some will use a roasted beet Charoset (a mixture of ground nuts, cinnamon and peeled chopped apples

Foods:

- Matzah
- •Grape juice or wine
- •Gefilte Fish with horseradish sauce. This is a most traditional part of many Seder meals and creates a special food connection for this celebration.
- •Macaroons. A traditional Passover dessert and again, can lend a special feeling of connection to this holiday.
